# Local Students Work to Combat Dying Bee Population

Students across Erie are doing their part to save colonies of bees, from dying at an alarming rate.

Wednesday, students at Strong Vincent High School planted a 'bee pole'.

Over the last 3 years, 98% of the colony bee population has died off.

The group 'Bee Pole Incorporated' started the project, run out of Erie.

They travel to schools all across the country, planting bee poles and spreading the message.

Officials said the goal is to bring back the dying population of pollinator bees.

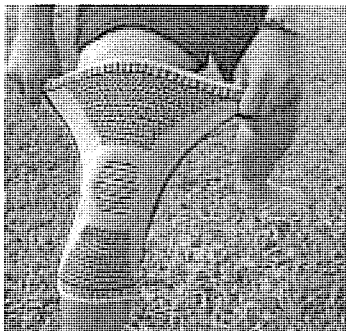
They said the pole helps to do that, because it works as a nesting site.

"What happens is we inject pheromones into the pole so when you plant it, the pheromones are released," said CEO and President of Bee Pole Inc., Chester Lee. "The Queen finds the scent, she follows it back, lays the larvae and on the twentieth day, the larvae hatches out," he said.

June 16th kicks off National pollinator week.

The group plans to use Facebook to spread the message and install bee poles from the shores of Lake Erie, all the way to the Gulf of Mexico.

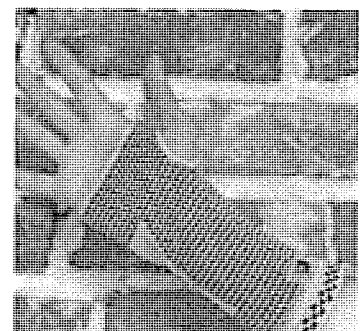
